The mission of Anchor Bible Church is to love God, love people, and make disciples of Jesus Christ.

The Triumphant Entry

The time had come for Jesus to fulfill what He had told his disciples three times before. Jerusalem was the destination where everything would unfold. Jesus knew what was going to happen. He tried to tell His disciples what would happen but it wasn't until it happened that they fully understood.

When they arrived at Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of His disciples to the village ahead. Here they would find a donkey colt that had never been ridden. They went to retrieve it for Jesus. As we can imagine the two disciples who went to retrieve the colt might have had the thought, "What if the colt isn't there? What if the owner says no?"

Jesus had instructed them on what to say when they arrived. "The Lord needs it and will send it back shortly." With that they untied the colt and brought it back to Jesus. The next thing we know Jesus was coming into Bethlehem and we hear shouts, "Hosanna, blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is the coming of the kingdom of our father David. Hosanna in the highest heaven."

Once again we see a fulfillment happening. At Jesus' birth in Bethlehem the announcement came from an angel of the Lord. "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:11).

God's plan of redemption has been unfolding from the Garden of Eden and would be completed in Jerusalem. Jesus doesn't overthrow religious or political leaders. Jesus doesn't encourage the disciples to rebel even though some wanted to. Jesus doesn't escape through a back alley.

Instead the Savior of the world enters Jerusalem on a donkey colt. If any part of this account was fabricated surely things would have unfolded differently. But they didn't. God shows us once again that He has come to serve and lay down His life for His creation.

Jesus knew what awaited him on His final ride into Jerusalem. He knew that His life would be the final sacrifice for our sins. Through Jesus' vicarious sacrifice we are shown God's love is pure and true.

Today, I pray that you and I embrace this truth. Not only in being told but that the Holy Spirit would show us that Jesus so loved us that He gave His life for us. That if we believe, we would receive His resurrected life through the power of the Holy Spirit. The only possible response, if we accept Jesus, is a transformed life set upon an eternal outcome with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

May it be for us to accept and be transformed to live a life for Jesus!

Occupation: Missionary, Evangelist, Historian in the early church

Gospel Origins: Mark was most likely in his teenage years during Jesus' life. It is a high probability that he listened to Jesus first hand. Mark was a great companion of multiple apostles. He was with Paul on his first mission (Acts 12:25-13:13) Later on Mark became Peter's most trusted attendant and scribe (1 Peter 5:12-13) This is where we get the original manuscript of the Gospel of Mark. Mark wrote down Peter's apostolic testimony.


