### **Real Connection**

Have you ever stopped to think about the connections you make? Our connections with the world and with other people and especially God are often overlooked. We are connected via wifi, email, phones, social media, tv's, even new vehicles of the day are so technologically advanced some drive for you.

With so many connections there is also a deep reality of our ability to disconnect from God and others. My prayer each week is that we would connect with God outside and inside the church body. These kinds of connections are different from the rest as they do not require a wifi, password, or electronics.

Real connection can be instantaneous or gradual. More often than not we approach God with an instantaneous view. We want the answer now, we want the miracle, the sign, and so on. I don't think it's a stretch to say we want things, even in our spiritual lives, "the easy way."

However, real connection isn't always neatly packaged or assessed with a password. Jesus tells us this in Matthew 11:28-30 28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." NIV.

I love how Jesus wants to connect with us. There is no filter needed, no prerequisite, just an extravagant invitation, "Come to me." Oftentimes we see our sins as disqualifiers into Jesus' words and without knowing it, we believe the lie that what Jesus said was for the other person. The person who has it together. Here is the newsflash, no one has it all together.

If you have been looking for a sign or a word to connect with God may it be right here for you. God's desire is to be the Lord of your life. To lead and guide you. To cleanse you from your sins and bring you to life everlasting.

Where is it today, this week, this month, year, and rest of our lives that we can disconnect from the ways of this world and connect with God? Here are three starting points to connect with and stay with.

- 1. Read His Word. Stop making excuses and start reading your Bible. How can we know God without listening and knowing what He says? Hebrews 4:12 NIV
- 2. Pray. We are not too busy and we surely aren't too important to talk to God through prayer. Matthew 7:7-12 NIV
- 3. Connect in His Church. God brings the believers together in the assembled body. We are to be the body of Christ, the bride of Christ. 1 Corinthians 12 NIV

My prayer for each of us in the month of May is that we would take Jesus at His word, live it out, and help others to know how God intentionally wants to connect with them too.

#### The Gospel of Mark's Background

Name: John Mark

Occupation: Missionary, Evangelist, Historian in the early church

Gospel Origins: Mark was most likely in his teenage years during Jesus' life. It is a high probability that he listened to Jesus first hand. Mark was a great companion of multiple apostles. He was with Paul on his first mission (Acts 12:25-13:13) Later on Mark became Peter's most trusted attendant and scribe (1 Peter 5:12-13) This is where we get the original manuscript of the Gospel of Mark. Mark wrote down Peter's apostolic testimony.

Key Themes:

- To present the person, work, and teachings of Jesus.
- Jesus fulfills God's promises to Israel.
- Follow Jesus or oppose Him.
- Servanthood Miracles Spreading the Gospel
