## "All In"

This past year has been one worth reflecting on. We have witnessed many come to faith. Others have deepened their faith walking closer and closer with Jesus. At the same time we would be naive not to acknowledge the trials and heartbreaks that happened in 2024. Such is the case in life, beautiful and downright difficult moments. ## **NOVEMBER 2024**

November expenses of \$32,115 exceeded contributions of \$23,966. This was due to a system technology upgrade cost of \$6,515 which we were able to pay due to a healthy checkbook balance. YTD contributions are short \$4,671 in covering expenses. We pray for a strong December to finish out the year. The Bulldog's GYM was blessed with over \$6,000 to help 18 families this season!

The signage and light pole project is near completion with a cost of \$36,753. \$11,232 was raised out of our challenge to raise \$13,000, which is a BIG praise. The remainder has been paid from the memorials that have been given over the years. Building Fund donations of \$3,938 covered our mortgage payment of \$2,843.
