

The mission of Anchor Bible Church is to love God, love people, and make disciples of Jesus Christ.

"Why do you look for the living among the dead?"

Three days had gone by since they last heard the shout of Jesus' last words, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." (Luke 23:46a, NIV) Everyone who believed and even those who did not believe witnessed Jesus shout this before He took his final breath.

Imagine the scene and the moment where those who loved Jesus were taken down from the cross to be buried. According to the Gospel of Luke we are given six verses to describe what happened from the cross to the tomb.

Joseph, a member of the council who did not consent to crucifying Jesus went to Pontious Pilate and asked to bury Jesus' body. A brand new tomb was nearby, Jesus' lifeless body was wrapped in linens and placed with the stone rolled across the opening. All of this was done in a timely manner as the Sabbath was about to begin.

In the background of this is a group of women who had come with Jesus from Galilee. They followed Joseph, saw the tomb Jesus' body was put to rest, and went home to prepare spices and perfumes. When Sabbath was done these women went to that very tomb.

When they arrived everything was different. The stone was rolled away. Jesus' body was gone! Suddenly, two men stood before them, their clothes gleaming like lightning. Frightened the women bowed before them. In all of what took place in this moment it wasn't the angels, or the stone rolled away but the question we can assume each woman was thinking, "Where is Jesus?"

Enter the famous question and answer from these two angels, "Why are you looking for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen!" (Luke 24:5b-6a)

We receive this account of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection in each Gospel and all throughout the rest of the New Testament. Jesus told us this would happen in order to redeem our lost, sinful, and broken lives back to God the Father.

The tomb of Jesus Christ is empty. Every worry, every sin of our lives was dealt with right there on the cross and in the empty tomb. But it doesn't end there, it only gets better.

Jesus ascended into heaven, where we await His return and each believer is ushered into eternity. So, take heart, hold fast to the hope and anchor of our souls, Jesus Himself, for He is alive forevermore!

In February we were challenged to match a \$10,000 donation to the Building Fund. Praise God the challenge was met with February giving \$16,979! Therefore, a \$27,000 principal only payment was made. Loan balance is now \$353,120. A reminder that when you give to the Building Fund, you need to mark it separate from the General Fund. Contributions to the General Fund were \$22,928 and expenses were \$24,758. Budget changes are being discussed with our pastor changes.
