"Tomb to Testimony"

He is risen, He is risen indeed... are words that have rang all throughout the world over the past weeks in remembering and celebrating Jesus' resurrection. The question posed to us in a recent sermon was "Are we living like Jesus' tomb is empty everyday?"

The tomb was empty yet beheld two angels (John 20:12) who spoke to Mary Magdalene. We hear this account and what follows with the disciples. We tend to find our answer to the question above in more ways than we admit in the disciple Thomas' response. "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." (John 20:25, NIV)

What in your life is holding you back from believing? Not a surface, lip service kind of belief but deep within your bones kind of belief. Personally, I think of the testimony of the Apostle Paul in his wrestling with sin. Romans 7, to be exact, is a testimony of our flesh meeting the heavenly grace of our Lord who has died for our sins.

This wrestling match, desiring to do and live out the will of God yet battling the flesh can only be found in the victory of Jesus Christ who has died, was buried, was raised from the tomb, and ascended into heaven 40 days later. The battle within that Paul talks about is explained multiple times by Jesus. It's where our hearts find their treasure!

If we are honest, the things holding people back from authentic faith and belief in Jesus is the location of the heart. My prayer for each of us is that our hearts would be found in Jesus. That he would be the treasure of our lives. In every moment, good or bad, Jesus would be the Lord of our lives.

Think once with me of the importance of Jesus' response to Thomas in John 20:29 "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

There, within Jesus' teaching, is a blessing that comes from believing. That blessing is life in Christ for eternity. The choice is ours everyday. I pray that we would choose to believe. I pray that we would choose to have one treasure of our hearts, life in Jesus!
