There are pivotal moments in our lives where we have the opportunity to look back at what God started 185 years ago to see where God continues to lead us into the future. Right now we find ourselves in one of those moments.

In 1841, God sent a Methodist Pastor by the name of John Hodges right here to Center Point to begin preaching the Gospel. By 1850, there were five different Methodist preaching places in town where the Reverend Hawn faithfully served. By 1865, the first church building was established at 321 Summit street (current home of Dan and Teresa Scheeler).

For 185 years the Word of God has been faithfully preached and lived out through this congregation. Our prayer is that in faith and by His grace, we, and the future generations of Anchor Bible Church, will continue what God began long ago.

On April 12th, the Finance Committee stood before the church body. Through fasting, prayer, and discernment brought forth a commission to “Anchor the Future”. From April to December 2026, a challenge to pay off our building loan was presented.

This is an opportunity for each of us to acknowledge and believe that God is the giver of everything. From our lives to our provisions, God is our foundation! By faith, we will continue to believe and help others come to the truth of the Good News of the Gospel!

I, along with the other pastors and leaders at Anchor Bible Church, ask you to join us in a faithful response to meet the goal of paying off our building loan by raising \$140,000.

Our Mission is to Love God, Love People, and Make Disciples. My prayer is that each of us would faithfully search our hearts and consider how God is calling us to respond. Because I truly believe we have just begun to see what God has in store for His Kingdom work through each of us!

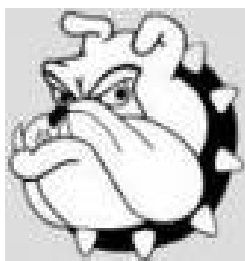

MARCH 2026

March General Fund giving \$44,396 was \$12,000 above March expenses! This makes the YTD giving above expenses by \$8,349. March Building Fund giving was \$5,934. On April 12, the Finance Committee presented uthe church body with "Anchor the Future" challenge to pay off the Building Loan by the end of this year. The March 31 loan balance was \$297,000. The congregation's challenge is to raise \$140,000 and the remaining will come from the Endowment Fund. Endowments are directives in someone's will to the church when settling their estate. Endowments have been life changing for our church. Our loan began 10 years ago at \$921,000. We feel this year we can work hard and get it paid off.
