## “Anchored Life Groups”

Over the past three weeks we have been focusing on the Biblical method of Discipleship in our Wesleyan heritage. The process is specifically known as class meetings (we will be calling them Anchored Life Groups), which played an important role in the spiritual lives of long ago and still remain vital today.

These Anchored Life Groups are a gathering of disciples who live out their faith together via a Biblical method of which John Wesley (founder of Methodism) called the general rules which were: Do no harm, do good, and attend to the ordinances of God.

Do no harm and do good are founded on the Biblical teaching of Jesus in John 13:34-35; 34 “A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

Every moment of everyday, we have the opportunity to be known as Jesus’ disciples in the way that we love one another. Do we always remember to live this out? Is the Love of the Lord on our hearts and minds everyday?

Sure, we fall short of God’s glory (Romans 3:23) but it is in the grace of our Heavenly Father to turn towards His love. After all, Jesus is the greatest example of love any of us can and will ever know!

As we prayerfully look forward to the formation of these new Anchored Life Groups (based on the classical class meeting structure) may we respond in love, growing deeper in love with Jesus and one another.

It is an opportunity for us not only as a church body to live out the love of Christ together but for the world around us. May we find our hearts and minds open to what God is doing through Anchor Bible Church.

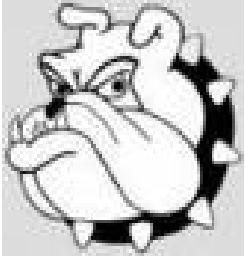

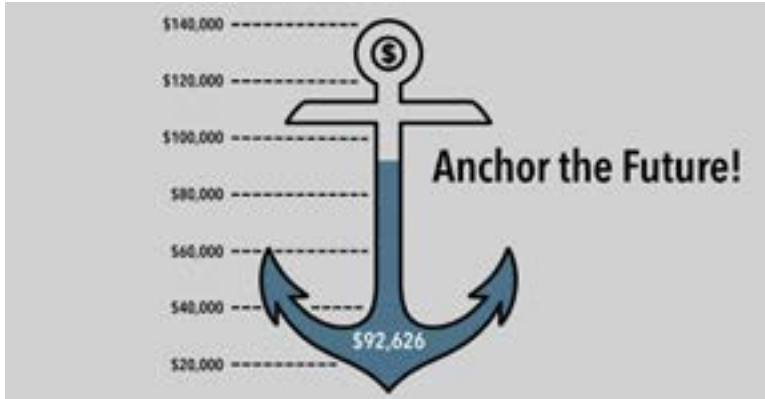
